2. Reports

USGS petition letter and web site update

3. Data DOI Task Force

Ellen Clarke asked about the data base having a DOI – Aude answered that the DOI is not for the data itself but the repository in its own right.

Aude – clarified the NC is not necessarily banning commercial just to be aware that it needs further discussion

Carol – USGS does not restrict any data – use CC 0 – so this is a government mandated approach. Simon said it could be a funding issue – Carol said not so far.

Alan asked that we looking to find a single license. Simon - reality is there will be differences – there already are.

Aude – proposes a task force on licensing – Ellen Clarke seconded it. Simon is agreed to lead it.

Kusumita – asked if it is only digital – Aude answered it is not only digital but analogue also

Tehre exists an International geosampling number – can then min DOI on that number which refers to the number.
