



Day Solar Report:- Northwestern Observatory, Spokane, Washington. (Single Unit Report)

Date: 12 August, 1958.

Times: 1930 — 1936 — 1938 — 1958 — Photos overlapping visual times from 1946 ut. 'til 2030 ut.

Sky Condition: Clear - Warm.

Solar Limb: fair to good

Apparatus Used: projection - Spectroheliograph (Ha) - photos (Ha).

Remarks: Observer:- Parmenter.

Most observing time spent at N. 42° - W 90° - Eruptive Prominence, which was in progress when first observed. On photos - allow 10,000 miles per m.m. - actual scale heights
