



Day Solar Report:- Northwestern Observatory, Spokane, Washington. (Single Unit Report)

Date: 22 August, 1958.

Times: 1910 — 1918 — 1919 — 1940 — 1941 — 1950 — visual again til 2000 ut.
 'projection' Spectroheliograph Photos
 other photos, at 2120-2130 ut of F-3 spot group

Sky Condition: clear, with "Smoky sky-haze"

Solar Limb: only fair - detail of surface 'coming + going'

Apparatus Used: projection - Spectroheliograph (H α) - photos (H α).

Remarks: Observer:- Parmenter.

Aurora sighted last eve at 10:30 P.M. P.S.T. of great intensity - in greenish-pearl + red hues, nearly to zenith. Dist activity hard to "follow" today, as "intermittency of brightenings" for C.A.'s almost continual over overlapping time periods.
