



Date: 28 May, 1961. **Observer:** Parmenter

Times: 16:50 — 16:58 u.t. (Integrated-light "Plotter") ← → 17:05 — 18:17 u.t. / P (Spectroheliograph)

Sky Condition: Mostly clear, some horizontal-haze about / P

Solar Limb: fair, to excellent, by "spells" / P

Apparatus Used: 7" Image Integrated-light "Plotter" ← → 10" aperture Spectroheliograph / P (in H α)

Remarks: area at N.8° - W.25° was from "brightly flared" to minus 1 class flare during observing-times - still in progress at end of the observing-period. (Further observation at 20:00 u.t. proved that active "flare-area" was only flared.)
