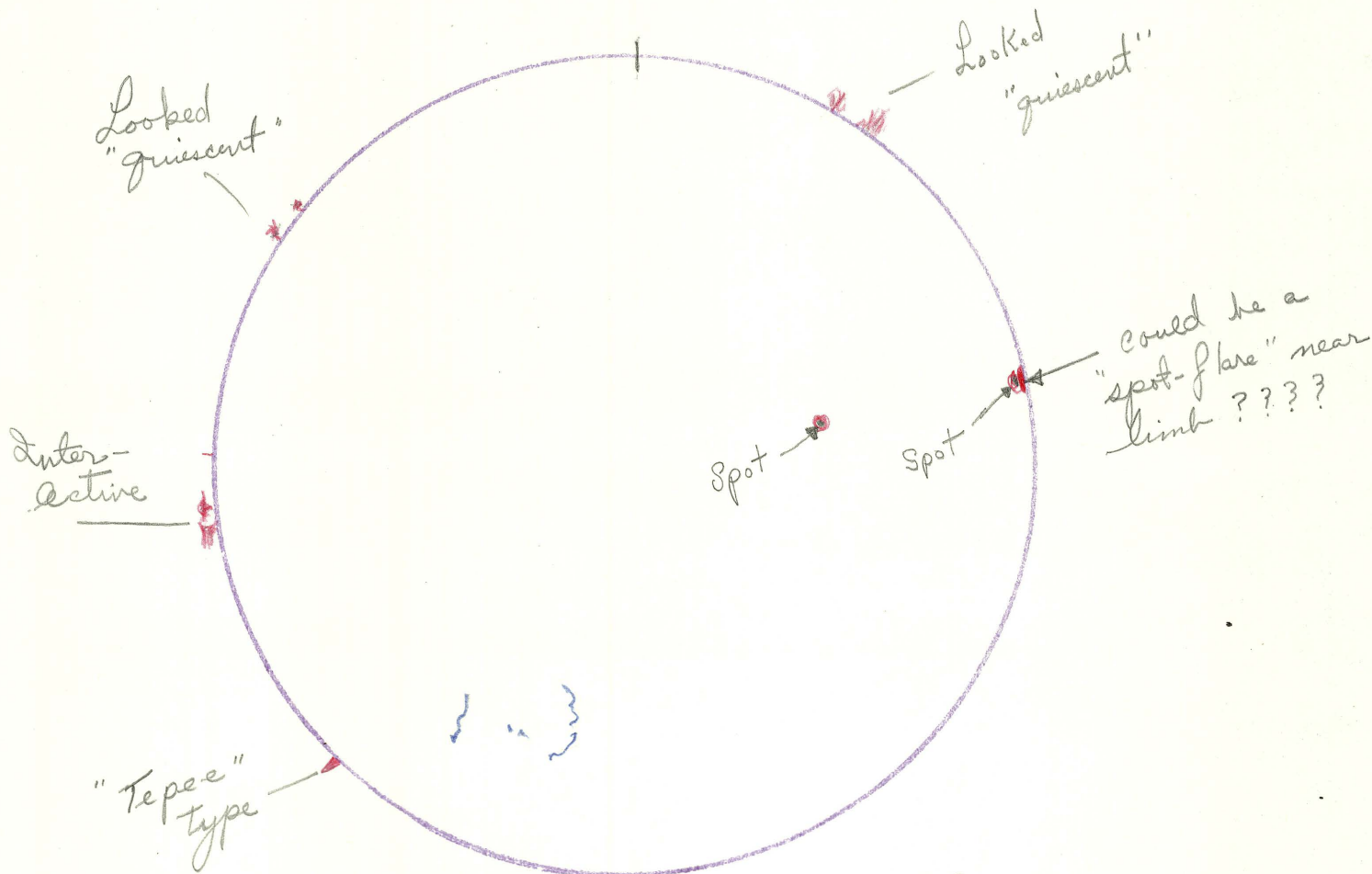


Rotation before Eclipse — 21 days —

Day Solar Report: NORTHWESTERN OBSERVATORY

Spokane, Washington



Date: 30 June, 1963.

Observer: Parmenter

Times: short observations, between fast-moving, heavy, dark, clouds — (used both "Plotter" & "Spectroheliograph at H α ", intermittently.)

Sky Condition Very "Blue" openings, between heavy, dark, rain-clouds.

Solar Limb: Very good.

Apparatus Used: (See above.)

Remarks: Looked for the "Large & Lacey" surface-prominence of my record 27 June, to have now been on the limb. Evidently, it had dissipated before doing so. The N.W. "proms" marked "Looked quiescent, may be some of this material.
