Sky Condition clear — (Hot) — "Milky-Blue"

Solar Limb: fairly good — Some atms "obscuration"

Apparatus Used: 7" Image "Plotter" ————— 10" aperture Spectrohelioscope (Ha)

Remarks: The S 23°/W. 90° "tall-stem", is yesterday's "surface-filament" now on limb, and observed "end on" & "Edgewise" — (Very narrow)
 The S. 39°/E. 90° "faint" is the "faint-stem" of past three days, progressing on "Disk-Shoulder", & now 5° farther South.
