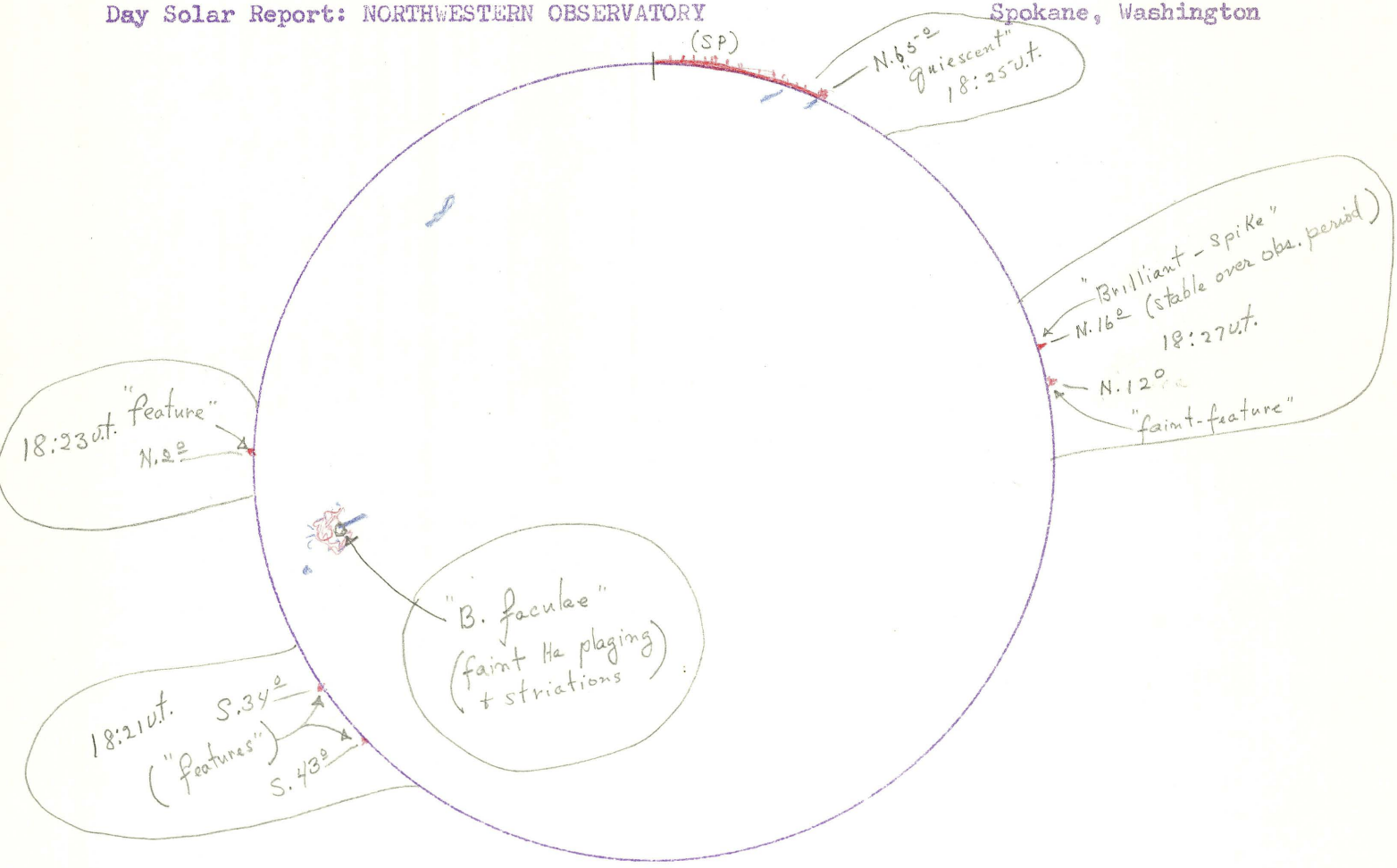


Day Solar Report: NORTHWESTERN OBSERVATORY

Solar Limb: Very good.

Apparatus Used: 7" Image "Plotter" ————— 10" aperture Spectroheliograph - (Ha)   
 graph - visually - (Ha)

Remarks: North Polar Region filled with spicules of quite "normal" size, but highly-active and showing Ha displacements for about 10% of their number. Displaced spicules exceedingly brilliant and active.
