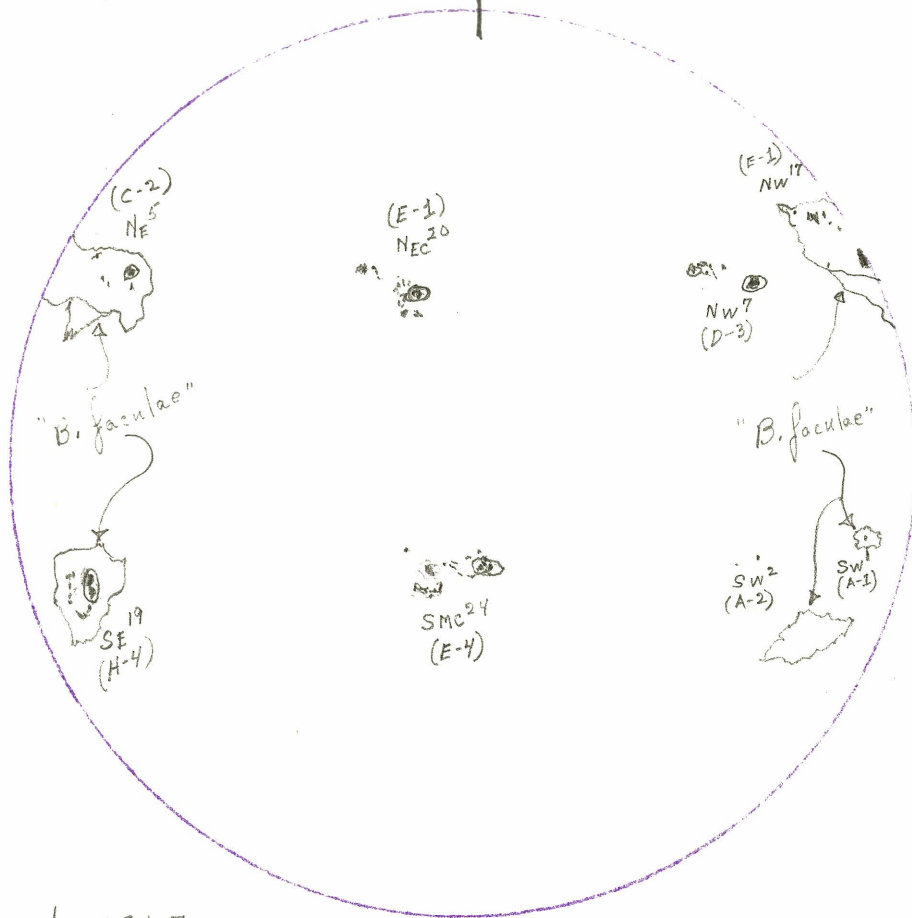

Day Solar Report:

NORTH-WESTERN OBSERVATORY

Everett, Washington



Date: 4 March, 1967

Observer: Parmenter

Times: 19:17 ut. — 19:32 ut. — "Plotter" only

Sky Condition: Mostly clear (cold)

Solar Limb: fair, to good, by "spells" (considerable turbidity - solar heating cold earth)

Apparatus Used: 7" Image "Plotter" — no H $\alpha$  observations

Remarks:

Better observation than 3 March, 1967, with improved classifications, although prominent spot-groups are singularly "borderline" (out-of-class)
