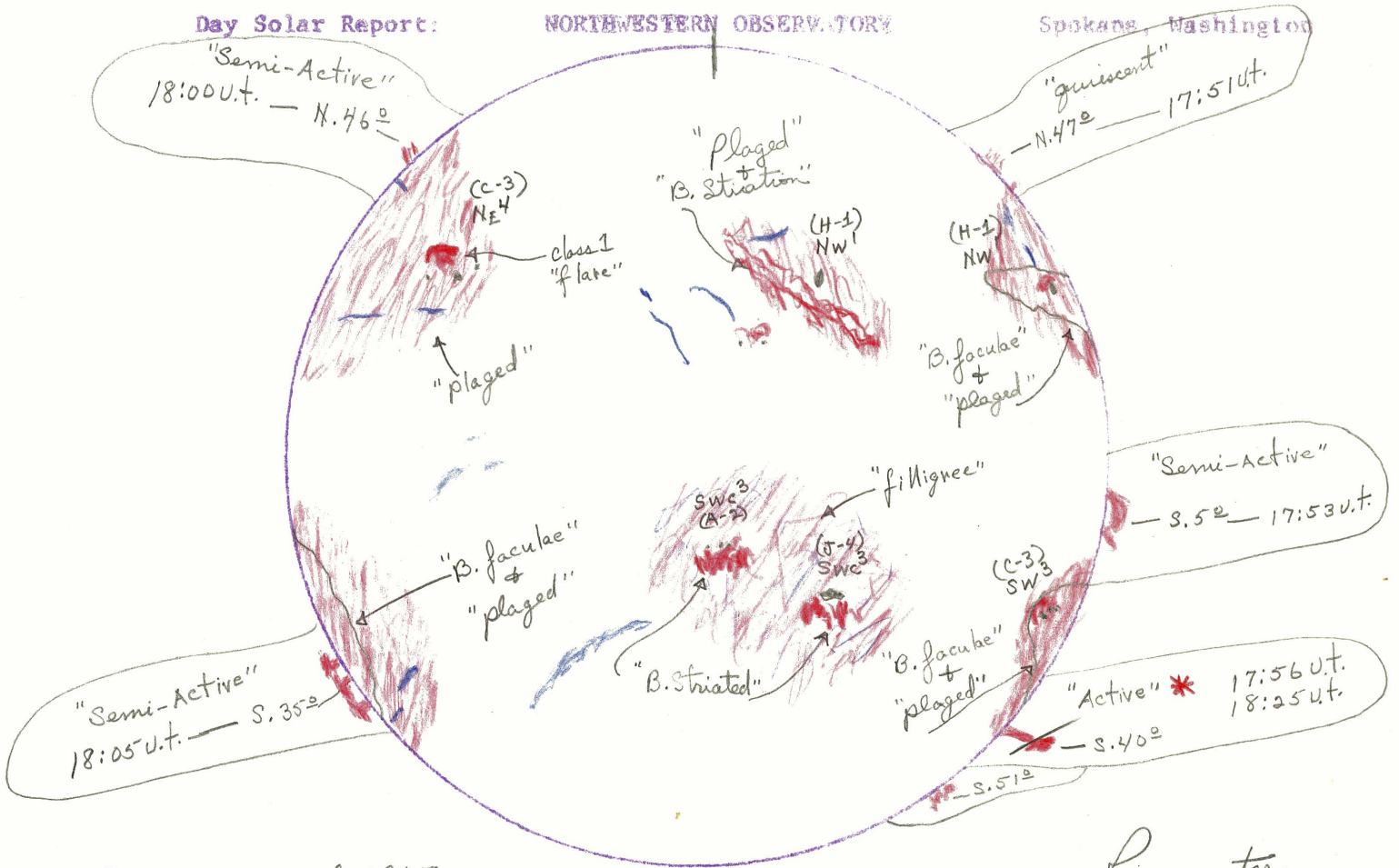

Remarks:

* S. 40°/W. 90° prominence displayed simple, tall, thin, stem at 17:56 U.T. — shortly thereafter becoming active, when it detached into "cloudlet" at height shown and becoming faint around 18:25 U.T.
