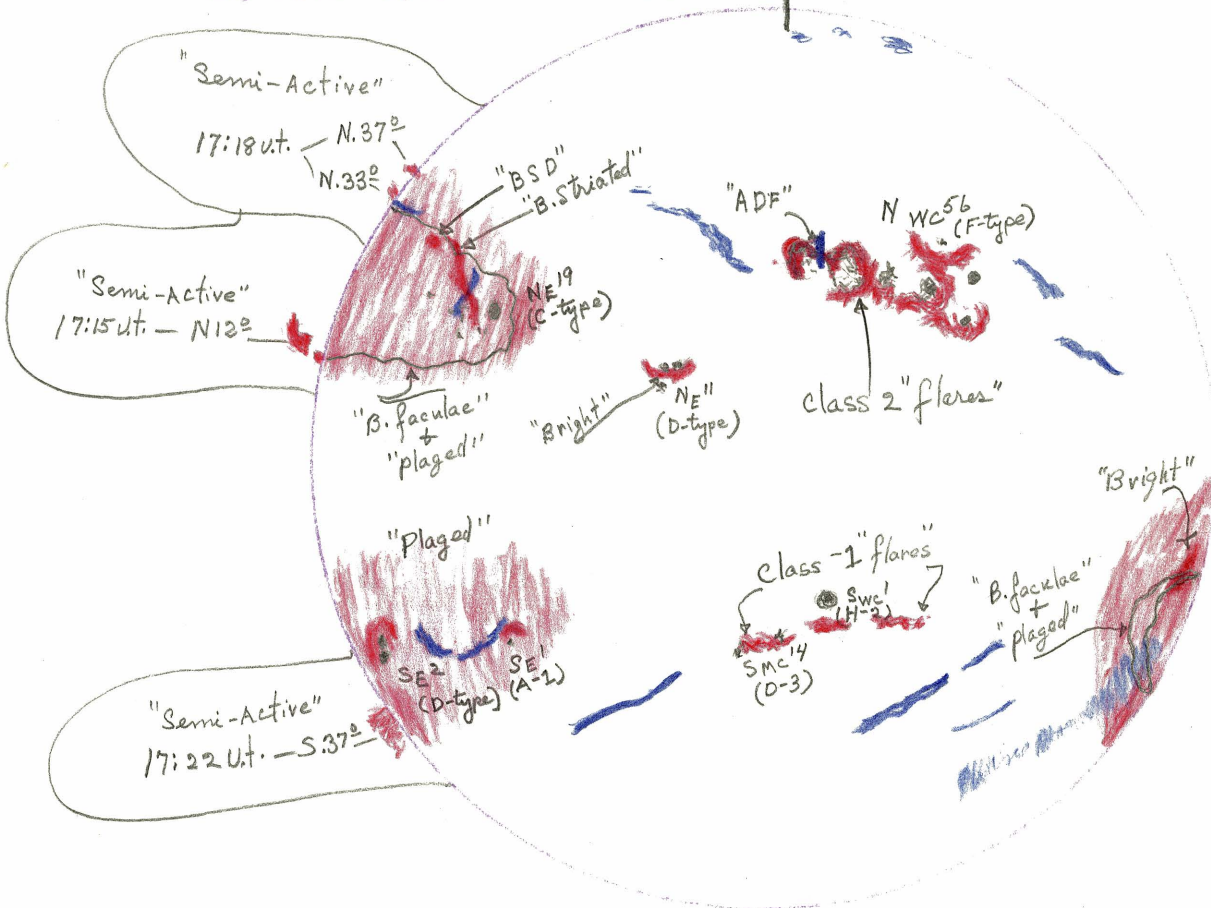

Times: 16:45 ut. — "Plotter" — 17:00 ut. — 17:05 ut. — Spectroheliograph > H α — 18:00 ut.

Sky Condition: Partially clear (cloud-outs)

Solar Limb: fair, to good, by "spells" — light monitor readings "Bouncing" on scale of 25-50 (areole obscuration)

Apparatus Used: 7" Image "Plotter" — 10" aperture tower Spectroheliograph > H α

Remarks:

Observances of Nwc⁵⁶ (F-type) group "flares" again at 21:00 ut. showed them to be fairly stable as to size and intensities. other "hot-spots," little changed.
