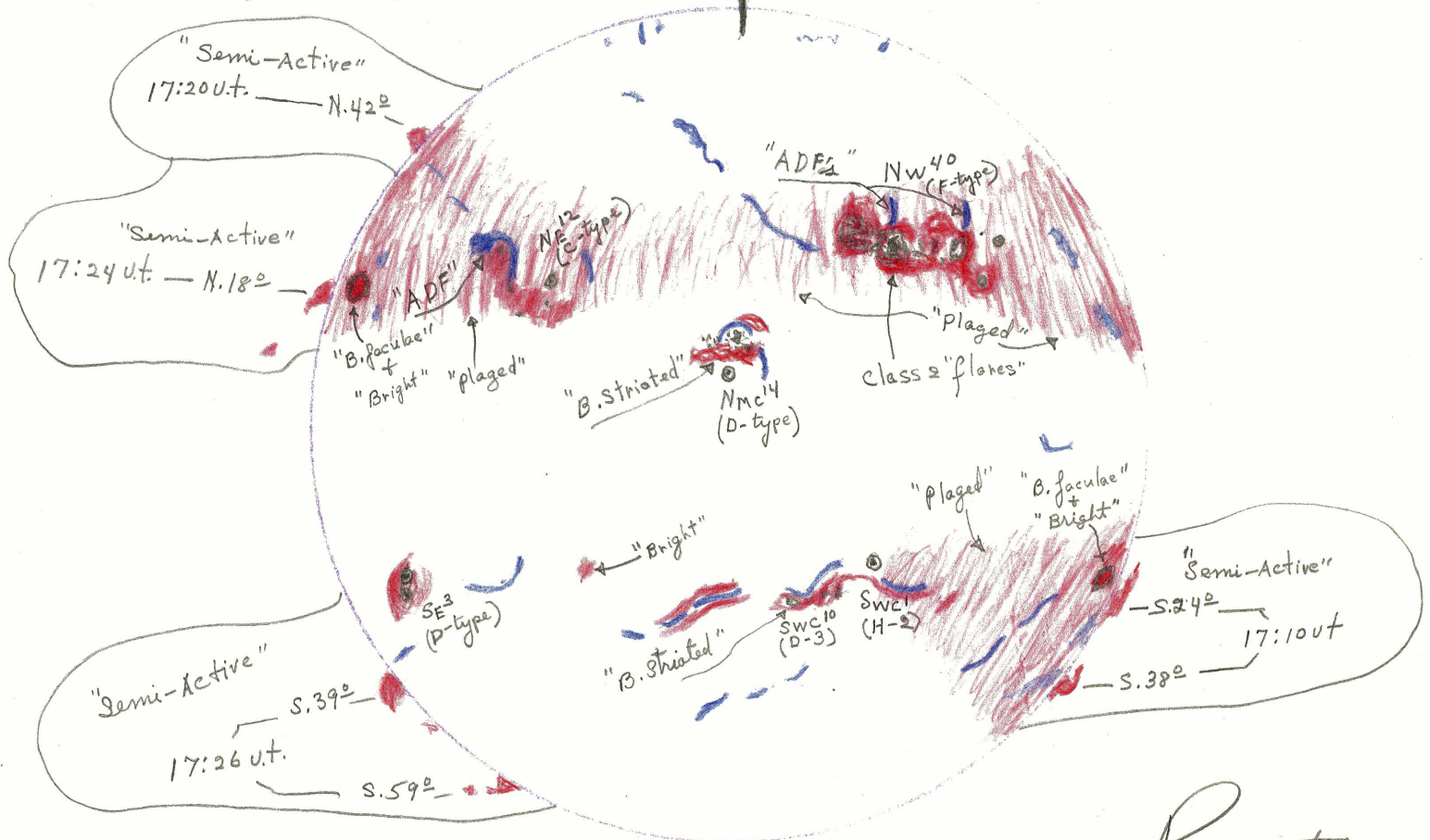

Times: 16:50 ut. — "Plotter" — 17:05 ut. — 17:07 ut. — 17:45 ut.

Sky Condition: Partially clear (overcast moved in)

Spectroheliograph → H $\alpha$

Solar Limb: fair, to good, by "spells" (atms obscurations)

Apparatus Used: 7" Image "Plotter" — 10" aperture tower Spectroheliograph → H $\alpha$

Remarks:

NW 40 (F-type) group "flares" of nearly same coverage, but of lowered intensities from prior times.
