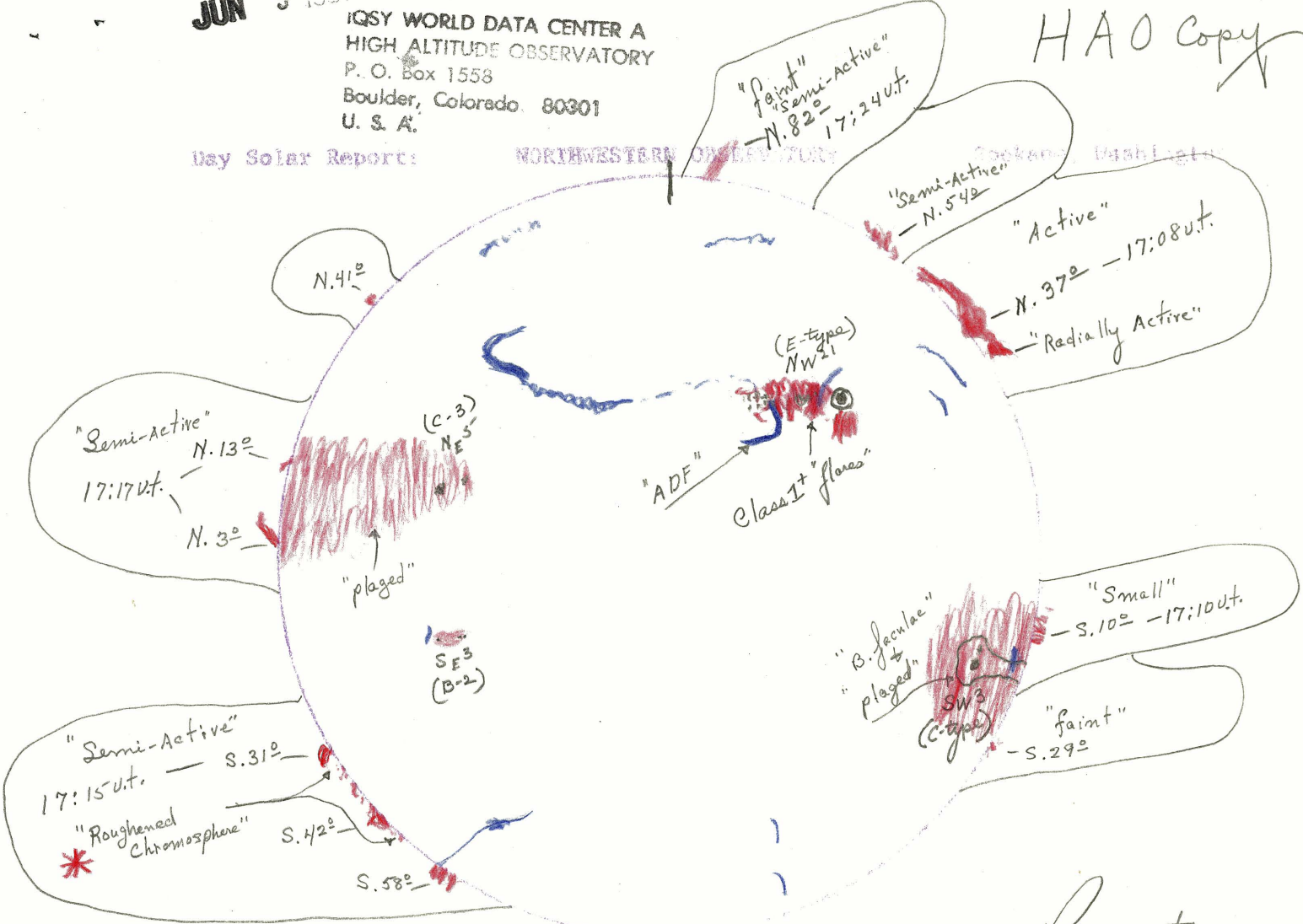

Spectroheliograph > H α

Solar Limb: fair, to good, by "spells" - (lowered light levels) (aureole obscurations)

Apparatus Used: 7" Image "Plotter" - 10" aperture tower Spectroheliograph > H α

Remarks:

Lowering activity-levels. Much aureole obscurations at times, due to a "tight, brilliant, small aureole surrounding sun over past weeks of intermittent inclement weather-pattern".
