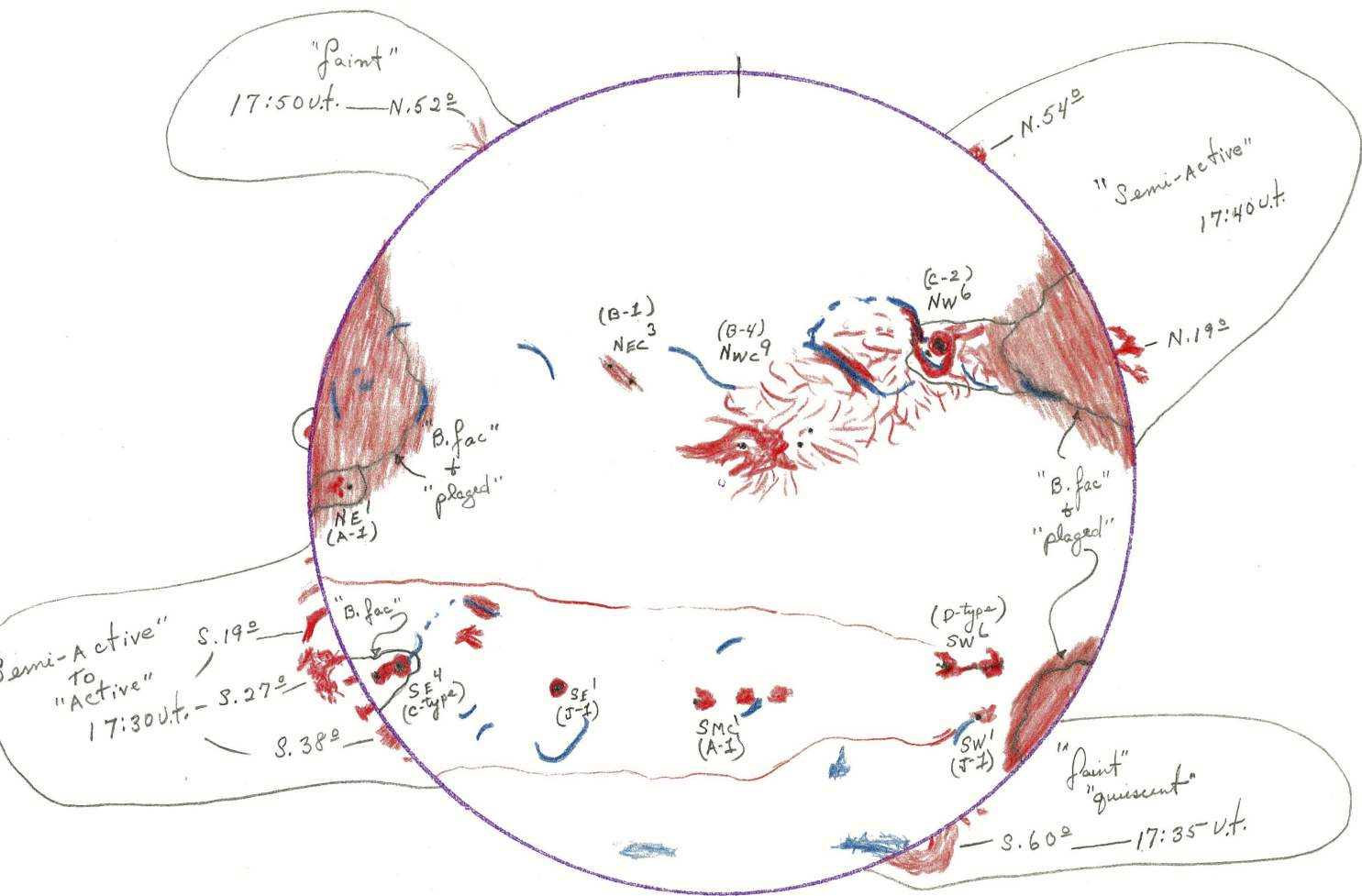


Day Solar Report

Times: 17:10 ut. plotter 17:22 ut. ——— 17:25 ut. ——— 18:45 ut.

Sky Condition: milky blue (some clouds about) Spectroheliograph → He

Solar Limb: fair, to good intermittently (some obscurations)

Apparatus Used: 7" Image "Plotter" — 10" aperture tower Spectroheliograph → He

Remarks:

Red line indicates extent of "plaging".

N.W. Hemisphere spot-groups displaying fairly large but "dull" intensities striations (sub-flares) and much bright "filigree".
