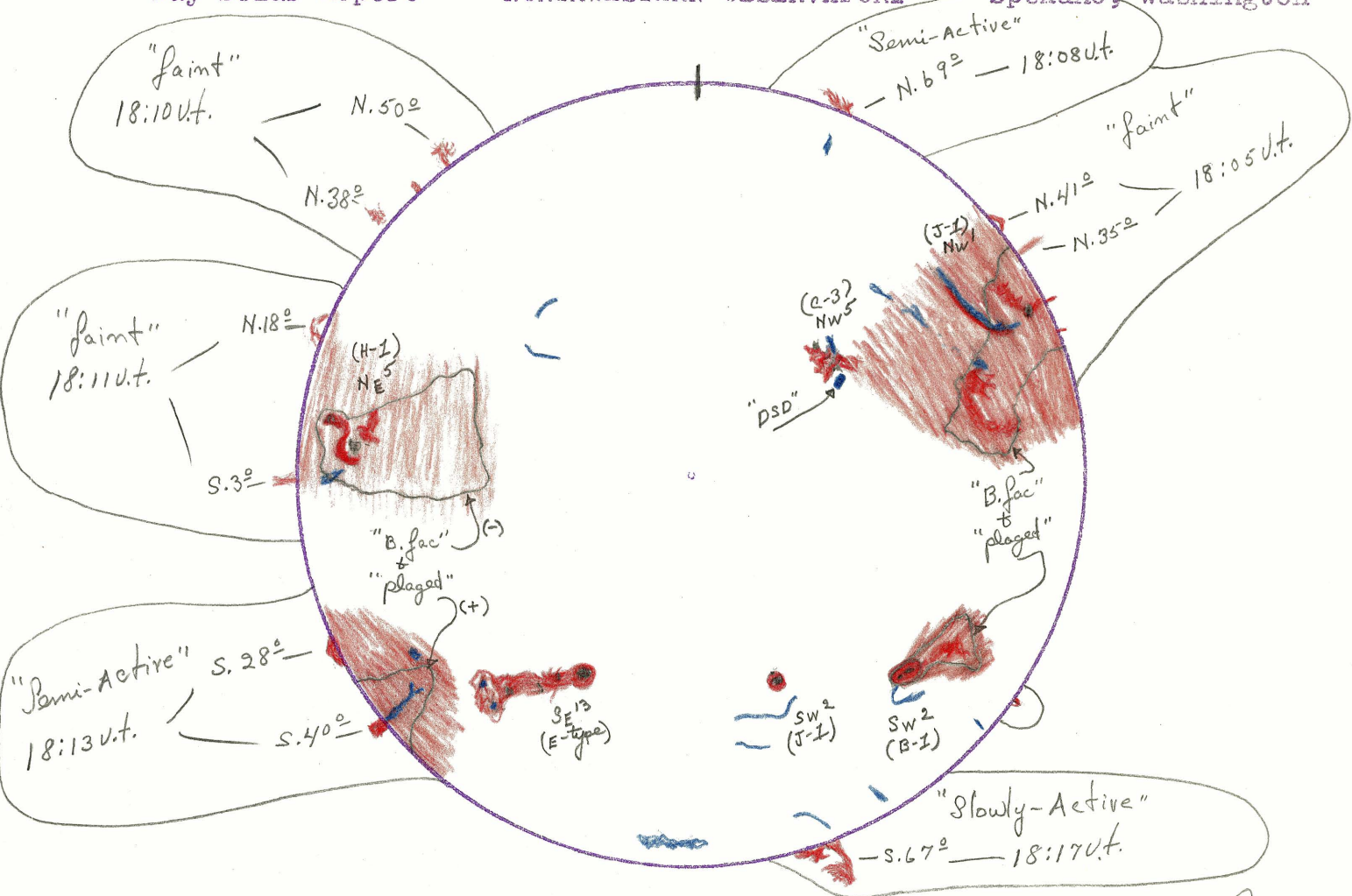


Day Solar Report

Times: 17:45 UT. — 17:57 UT. — 18:00 UT. — 18:35 UT.

Sky Condition: "Plotter" — Spectroheliograph > H α Large opening (overcast came in)

Solar Limb: observations made through thin cloud-strata on overcast periphery.

Apparatus Used: 7" Image "Plotter" — 10" aperture tower Spectroheliograph > H α

Remarks:

Regions near spottedness displaying low intensities "bright platings" or "dull" striations (sub-flares)

Generally, activity-levels "moderate"
