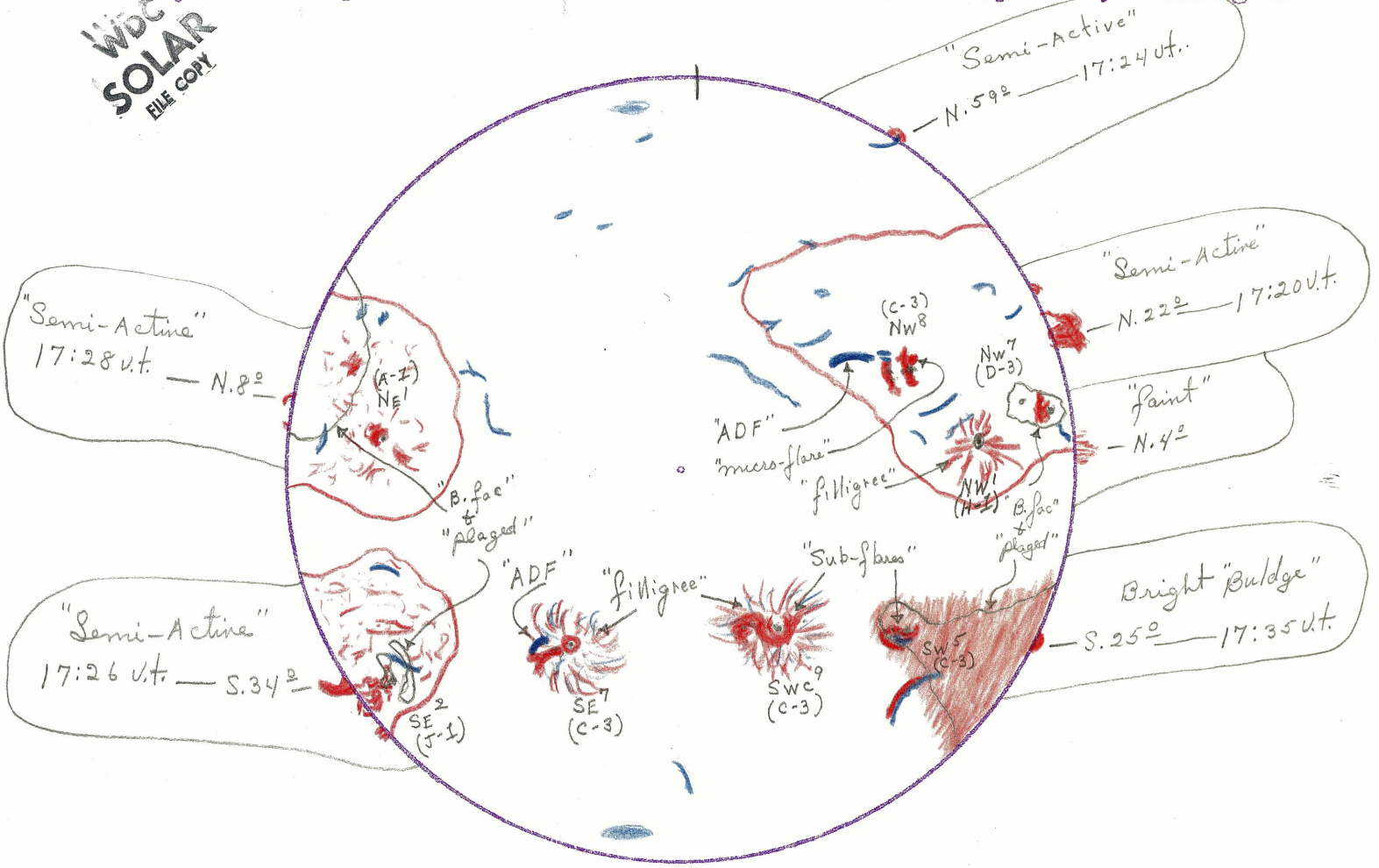

Apparatus Used: 7" Image "Plotter" — 10" aperture tower Spectroheliograph > Ha
